## School Achievements – Academics

The year 2019-20 definitely started with a bang! The third batch of students who appeared for Grade X exams came out with gratifying results. It was 100% pass out where in Samruddhi Patil elevated herself as grade topper with 98%, Prathamesh Kumbhar kept very close at 97.4% and Soham Dhanokar enveloped at 96.8 %.

Out of 206 students who appeared for the exam, 14 students scored a perfect 100 in various subjects, and 11 more students achieved a perfect 99. 40 students grabbed 90 and above percentage. 147 students secured distinction.
